

Colonial First State Email Communication Competition Conditions of entry

1. Information on how to enter and prize details set out in all communications regarding the Colonial First State Email Communication Competition (the "**Promotion**") form part of these Conditions of Entry. By entering this Promotion you agree to be bound by these Conditions of Entry. Any application not complying with these Conditions of Entry is invalid.
2. The promoter is Colonial First State Investments Limited (ABN 98 002 348 352) of Level 5, South building, 11 Harbour Street Sydney NSW 2000 Australia (the "**Promoter**") telephone 13 13 36.
3. The Promotion commences at 12.01am (AEST) on Thursday 12 January 2012 and closes at 4:59pm (AEST) on Friday 30 March 2012 (the "**Promotion Period**").
4. A person is eligible to enter into the Promotion provided that person satisfies the following eligibility requirements ("**Eligibility Requirements**"):

6. The first account name drawn which satisfies clause 5 from the valid entries entered (the "**Winner**") will win 2 economy class return air tickets to Paris from any Australian capital city, where applicable, up to the value of \$5000 (the "**Prize**").

The flights:

- o Are subject to availability, wait lists will not be entertained.
- o Must be booked and ticketed by 29 June 2012.

The Promoter is not responsible for any problems or technical malfunction of any telephone network or lines, computer on line systems, servers, or providers, computer equipment, software, technical problems or traffic congestion on the Internet or at any web site, or any combination thereof, (including, but not limited to) any injury or damage to participants or any other person's computer related to or resulting from participation in or down-loading any materials in this Promotion.

18. To the extent permitted by law, the Promoter and its related entities and its and their respective directors, officers, employees and agents, will not be liable for any:

(a) loss or damage whatsoever which is suffered or sustained (including, but not limited to indirect or consequential, financial or other loss); or

(b) personal injury suffered or sustained in connection with your participation in the Promotion or the receipt or use of the prize by the Winner or any person accompanying the Winner.
